Mayor Anderson has reviewed the applications for the vacant PDA position as well as the City Council Members' recommendations. Based on this information, he has selected <u>Dennis Hardman</u> for appointment.

Centralized Urban Renewal Area-Targeting Strategy

Identifying where resources of urban renewal should be targeted and how projects of urban renewal should be prioritized are important factors to success. The creation of an urban renewal area can target resources and the creation of an urban renewal plan can prioritize projects. Together, the Urban Renewal Area and Plan can be the catalyst for a renewed central area in Pocatello.

Geographic Priority

As recommended by the Pocatello Development Authority, the Central Urban Renewal Area will target resources by priority area. The proposed areas are:

Central Commercial Area: All properties in this area will be included in a revenue allocation district within the Urban Renewal Area. It is proposed that eighty five percent of Tax Increment Financing funds generated in the district be used in this area. In addition to Tax Increment Financing, Business Improvement Districts may be created to provide additional resources for implementation of plans.

Central Residential Rights-of-Way: All public rights-of-way in this area will be included in a revenue allocation district within the Urban Renewal Area. Fifteen percent of the Tax Increment Financing funds generated in the district is proposed to be used to fund public right-of-way improvements as identified in the plan. Additional funding sources may come from the creation of Local Improvement Districts.

Non-Central Areas: Outside of the Central Urban Renewal Area, additional urban projects will be at the discretion of the PDA based on the type of business activity, the number of jobs created, and the level of private investment as follows:

- -Manufacturing Businesses are eligible (Retail Establishments are ineligible)
- -Meet state guidelines for Urban Renewal Area
- -Creation of 25 or more jobs
- -Construction investment of \$5-10 Million or more
- -100% TIF eligible with a 5 year maximum project duration


