June 2, 1998:

Frasure Construction to begin removing existing concrete sidewalk between points identified and marked by the City. Proper traffic control is the contractor's responsibility. Care should also be given to providing local businesses access during construction.

June 3-4, 1998:

Frasure to complete sidewalk removal. Shepherd Engineering to complete inspection and to resolve any problems. Frasure to recompact base to 95 percent and Shepherd to inspect final compaction.

June 4-5, 1998

City Street Department to replace sidewalk.

If problems or questions arise, please give me a call at 234-6184. I have already spoken to affected property owners to make them aware of this work schedule. Efforts, therefore, to minimalize deviations is expected and greatly appreciated.
