RECAP OF BID RESULTS DOWNTOWN REINVESTMENT PROJECT PHASE I May 19, 2004

Statements of qualifications from prospective contractors were required to be able to proceed to the bidding phase. Qualification submittals included a history of performance, project references, team qualifications, local labor, construction equipment, approach to the project, bonding ability and a statement of available labor and wages. Qualified contractors were asked to bid the project, and Tuesday, May 11, 2004 three bids were opened. The project was bid with a base bid and additional alternate bids to provide flexibility and costs for additional items such as a concrete intersection and additional trees. Base bids of \$2,624,191.10, \$2,719,259.70, and \$2,863,327.20 were received from BECO Construction Co., Inc., Jack B. Parsons Companies, and HK Contractors, Inc., respectively. Additional alternate bid items, excluding the concrete intersection, bring the low bid submitted by BECO to a total contract price of \$2,696,976.10. Detailed bid tabulations are available if needed. BECO is a local company and boasts over 90% local labor provided for this project.

Our engineer's estimate is \$2,192,672.40; or a difference of \$504,303.70 over the low bid. Speculation for the overages range from recent dramatic increases in the cost of steel and recycled steel availability which is used in the manufacture of the water pipe, fuel cost increases, general recent trends in the construction industry, and reduced competition for this type of work in our area.

The bid review committee has carefully studied the bids and looked at options such as rejecting all bids and re-bidding later and removing items from the existing bid. The feeling is, the project has been scrutinized throughout the design process and several, if not all, cost saving measures have already been incorporated into the bid. In addition, re-bidding at a later date does not guarantee the city will get a lower bid. Indeed, it is likely the affects of inflation will drive the costs up even more.

Although this bid is over the estimate, there is adequate budget in the next two phases to be able to proceed with this bid and construct this phase this summer. Lessons learned from this phase will be applied to the next two phases and additional opportunities to save money in the next phases will be explored.

Once awarded, this project will begin June 7th and the contractor will have 90 calendar days for completion.
