Enclosed herewith is a conformed copy of the JUB Settlement Agreement which has now been executed by all parties. The original Agreement will be filed in the City Clerk's office.

As you know, the total settlement with JUB is for the sum of \$147,896.00, eighty percent of which will be paid by the PDA. By my calculation PDA's share of the settlement payment is the sum of \$118,316.80. Please deliver the check to me, made payable to JUB and I will forward it along to JUB's counsel.

Also enclosed is a copy of the mediator's bill, in the amount of \$7,627.00. The bill is higher than I expected. I am particularly curious of the three-hour charge that he shows for September 27, 2006. I am sure it took me less than an hour to write my proposed changes to the Settlement Agreement. I don't know why it would take him three hours to "receipt and review" those changes and then call Tom Arkoosh. However, overall, the bill is not out of line for charges customarily made by lawyers of his experience. The City/PDA responsibility is for onehalf the bill, which is the sum of \$3,813.50. Of that, PDA's 80% share is \$3,050.80. Please provide me with a check payable to Hawley, Troxell, Ennis & Hawley, for payment of this expense and I will forward it along to Mr. Clark.

Attached is documentation outlining the Pocatello Development Authority's (PDA) final share of costs for the Downtown Reinvestment Project, Phase II. The final PDA share equates to \$97,059.26.

Since this is the final PDA billing on this project I would like to summarize the total project costs. The total construction cost, including two change orders, is \$2,459,731.42, which is \$95,170.08 below the Contractors original bid amount. Other project costs included material testing and quality control in the amount of \$6,847.50 and costs for advertising and soil stabilizer for the structural fill in the amount of \$3,445.50. Thus the total project cost equates to \$2,470,024.42 making the PDA's share at 80% \$1,976,019.53.

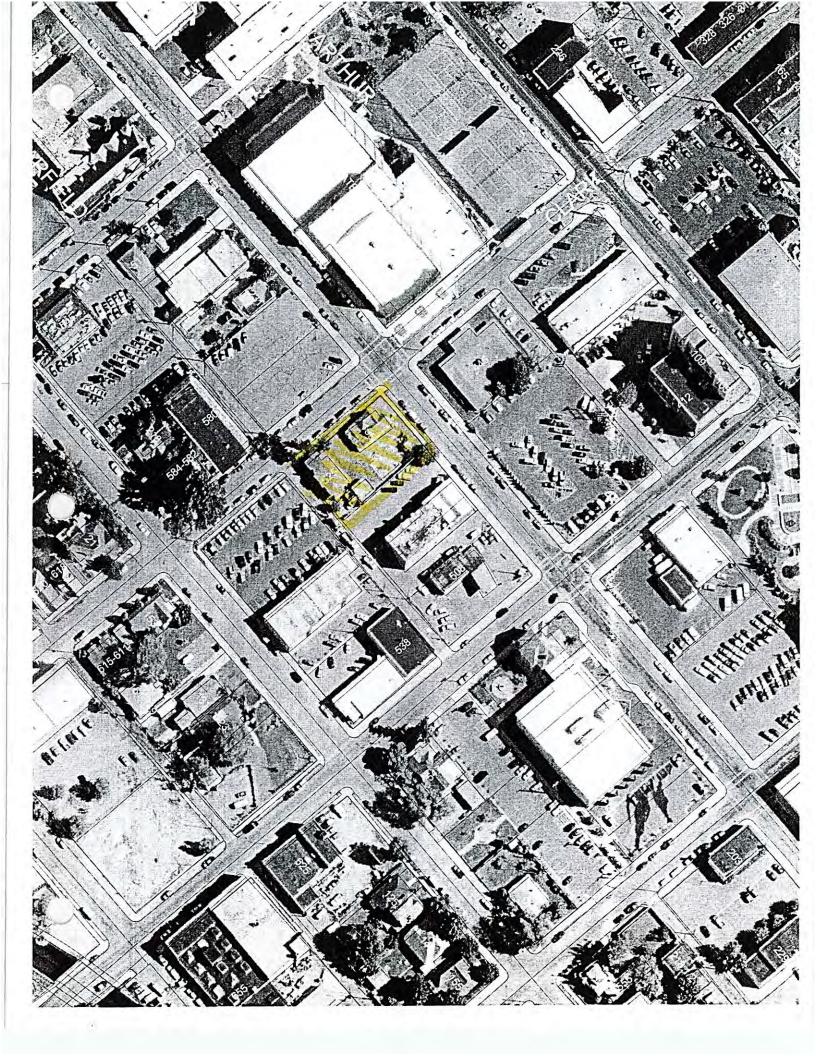

PDA Audit

Gynii;

I have some thoughts on the topic of a new auditor for the Pocatello Development Authority (PDA).

Dean Tranmer showed me the draft letter from you that solicits proposals for a new auditor. He invited me to attend the PDA meeting today to discuss the topic.

It's very late to engage a new auditor at this point. Your fiscal year ends Dec 31, 2006. A proper audit includes some field work, some of which is properly done prior to fiscal year end. PDA is simpler, but I still think it will be difficult to engage a new auditor and have your financials out on time. If you want to make a change from Deaton & Co, then I suggest that you do that for your FY2007 report, not FY2006.

As I read the letter, it seemed to me that PDA is asking for someone to do two things. First, we want an audit of PDA's financials. Second, we want someone to prepare the financials. That is, to actually write the Management Discussion & Analysis, the financial statements, the notes, the required supplementary information, etc.

There is a fundamental problem with that. An auditor cannot audit his or her own work. As a minimum, Deaton must assign the tasks to different CPAs. That's helpful, but really doesn't cut it. New changes to the "Yellow Book" (auditor's guidelines) make it very questionable whether the same firm can prepare and audit. There is too much potential "conflict of interest and the industry has really tightened up on it.

It's PDA's business, but as the CFO of the city, I have an interest in this. PDA is what the financial community refers to as a "component unit." PDA is legally separate from the city, has its own bank account and its own assets and liabilities. But the city appoints the membership of the board. We can have the city council perform the function of the board. Thus, the City of Pocatello can impose will on the PDA. Therefore, GASB criteria for our financial statements would say that excluding PDA from our city financials would be misleading. So we include them. We present PDA's financial activity as a discrete presentation, but PDA's numbers are in the city's financial statements. Those numbers have to be reliable, audited numbers. They need to have a clean audit, and that means one that is untainted by potential conflict of interest, which means I don't want your auditor to be auditing financials that he or she prepared.

Does that mean that PDA needs to hire two different firms at considerable increased cost? Yes. Like many small entities, you are faced with new unfinanced mandates to comply with new rules. Post Enron, you have to spend more money on financial statements and the audit.

I have a suggestion. But before I suggest it, I want to point out one more problem. Your fiscal year does not correspond to the city's. By state law, city fiscal years in Idaho begin on 1 Oct and end on 30 Sept (Idaho Code 50-1001, "the fiscal year of each city shall commence on the first day of October." PDA has their fiscal year 1 Jan to 31 Dec. What that means is that as the city prepares it's financials in Nov & Dec for the previous fiscal year, PDA is still operating and has no audited numbers yet. The PDA report is normally too late for us to include. So we include last years report. That's not good. Part of accountability is not only accuracy, but timeliness. Including PDA numbers that are more than one year old does not enhance the city's accountability in its own financials. I want to fix that.

Ray Burstedt and I talked some about this, but the issue was overcome by events. My read of urban renewal law says the development authority is required to have the same fiscal year as the city (Idaho Code 50-2006), but there is another section of the code that seems to contradict that. Whatever; I merely point out the problems of having them

different and the merits of having them the same.

On to solutions. I propose that PDA continue to engage Deaton & Co to audit your EX2006 financials. But I propose that the Finance Department of the City of Pocatello epare your financials. I will assign Jerry Higgins, the city treasurer to do this.

Deaton will audit Jerry's work. This will make me comfortable with the numbers and will save PDA the money that you would otherwise spend on a preparer. Jerry has done it before and we don't think it will take that much work. It will have the meritorious quality of making our offices work more closely together.

I further propose that your FY2007 fiscal year last only nine months. It will end on September 30, 2007. We will prepare 9 month financials and Deaton (or a new company if you choose to engage) will audit them. Henceforth, PDA's fiscal year will run 1 Oct to 30 Sept. I think this puts PDA in compliance with state law and also makes the coordinated presentation of PDA as a component unit in our city financials much more workable.

Finally, I would suggest that if there is dissatisfaction with the PDA financial reports, it is probably not in your audited annual presentation. That is for the bondholders. What your board probably cares about is "where are we at" as they make management decisions. The information they need is management information, not audited financials statements prepared according to GAAP established by GASB. Part of it is that the PDA needs to take budgeting more seriously and the board has to have some budget meetings. Management needs to provide better monthly or quarterly updates. I'm not sure what is required because I haven't heard what the dissatisfaction is, but I would offer to help in this regard.

Wanted to make you aware of my thoughts on this before today's meeting. I tried to call you and I will try again after I send this.
